Thirty years after Henry Ford's failed attempt to occupy the banks of the Tapajó to produce rubber, billionaire Daniel Ludwig tried to establish a large extraction project on the Jari River. The film explores the dramas and dreams of the local residents, 50 years after the industrial operation began. Amid promises of progress, poverty and violence, the director reflects on the need for a new concept of development for the Amazon.
