Webinar Launch: "Trigger Change! Innovations in Sustainable Urban Land Restoration"



Housing and Property Restitution for Refugees and Displaced Persons. Implementing the Pinheiro Principles in the Middle East and North Africa

The publication offers practical guidance for protecting the housing, land and property rights of refugees and internally displaced persons in the MENA region. Adapted from the global 2007 Handbook. It highlights the importance of returning land to its rightful owners as part of durable solutions and stresses that land restitution must be supported by broader structural reforms to address the root causes of displacement. The guidance promotes coordinated

efforts across humanitarian, development and peacebuilding sectors to ensure just and sustainable land restoration in post-conflict recovery. Find the publication <u>here.</u>
