



Generation Restoration: Join a year-long global journey to shine a light about restoring our earth

The UNCCD G20 GLI has launched Generation Restoration Dialogues, a year-long webinar series aimed at engaging youth and educators in global land restoration efforts. Held monthly, the series links restoration to key global issues like biodiversity, food systems, jobs and culture. The first session took place on 20 May 2025, moderated by Keely Chauke, and featured speakers John Mbugua Kimani, Joshua Steib and Dr. Nick Leimu-Brown. Discussions focused on youth-led restoration, the impact of food systems and restoring ecosystem services. After Action Report START Summit x Hack 2025

The G20 GLI, launched by G20 leaders in 2020 to reduce global land degradation by 50% by 2040, participated in the START Summit x Hack 2025 to engage emerging talent and drive innovation toward this ambitious goal. Held annually in St. Gallen, Switzerland, the START Summit is Europe's largest student-led conference and hackathon focused on entrepreneurship and technology, drawing over 7,000 participants including founders, investors, policymakers and developers. G20 GLI's involvement in the event, particularly in the START Hack segment with over 600 top students, provided a platform to explore techdriven solutions to real-world land restoration challenges while raising awareness of the initiative's mission among future leaders and changemakers. <u>'There is no Solution to Climate Change, Biodiversity Loss</u> <u>Without Healthy Forests', Says Senior Official, as Forum on Forests Opens Session</u>

The United Nations Forum on Forests opened with strong calls to prioritise forest protection as essential to tackling climate change and biodiversity loss. Leaders and experts emphasized the urgent need for sustainable forest management, enhanced financing, innovation and multilateral cooperation. Countries shared national efforts and challenges, including successful afforestation policies and a lack of resources, while also endorsing the




