After a very successful first grant round in which 39 organisations from 22 countries received funding, we are thrilled to launch the next round of the Restoration Returns Grant! This grant supports organisations working on land restoration, helping to revive ecosystems, restore degraded landscapes and improve livelihoods. Selected organisations will receive \$17,000 USD to advance their restoration projects and create lasting environmental and community impact. United Against Drought: Riyadh Partnership Moves to Action

This aims to shift from crisis response to proactive drought risk reduction through early warning systems and sustainable land management. At its inaugural conference, stakeholders agreed on governance, financing and technical support to help vulnerable countries.

Resurrecting Dead Soils

In Kenya, the BOOST initiative by FAO, IFAD and the EU is reviving degraded soils through agroecological training and support hubs. Farmer Agnes Barasa transformed her yields by switching to organic practices, increasing her corn harvest fivefold. BOOST has reached 40,000 farmers across five counties, improving soil health and food security.






From Dumpsite to Dream: How Green Go is Transforming Eldorado Park with Greenpop & Heineken

Drought Hotspots Around the World 2023-2025

Global climate patterns in 2023 and 2024 produced record-breaking heat and severe drought impacts that continue into 2025, causing water shortages, food insecurity and displacement, especially in parts of Africa. This report identifies the regions most affected by these droughts and examines their social, economic and environmental vulnerabilities. It explores the climatic factors that intensified these impacts and highlights why understanding them is essential for better mitigation and resilience planning. By analysing these drivers and vulnerabilities, the report offers actionable insights for policymakers, researchers and humanitarian organisations. Find the summary article here and the report here.

Global Wetland Outlook 2025: Valuing, Conserving, Restoring and Financing Wetlands (GWO25)

The Global Wetland Outlook 2025 warns that without urgent action, 20% of the world's remaining wetlands could vanish by 2050, risking \$39 trillion in essential benefits like clean water, food production, flood protection and carbon storage. Wetlands are disappearing faster than any other ecosystem, with 22% already lost since 1970 and severe declines in regions like Latin America, the Caribbean and Africa. The report calls for coordinated investment and outlines solutions including integrating wetland value into planning, innovative financing and public—private partnerships for restoration. Featuring global data and success stories, it serves as a roadmap to align wetland conservation with climate, biodiversity and development goals. Read more hetero.
