<u>COP15: Report of the Secretariat on assessment of Progress on</u> <u>Wetland Restoration</u>

Drawing on scientific literature, global data and case studies, the report evaluates restoration commitments and activities in line with Strategic Plan Target 12 and the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework. The findings will guide efforts to accelerate wetland restoration, enhance implementation and align with broader global restoration targets under the SDGs and the UN Decade on Ecosystem Restoration.
